Farmhouse Amita located in Appennino, a medieval village of Tuscany, encircled by forests of faggi and chestnut trees was recently restored. The guests can visit Frascole archeological excavations of Poggio di Frascole, one of the main archeological complexes of Mugello and Valdisieve. The farmhouse is in two floors. The ground floor has a spacious sitting-room, with panoramic view of the splendid Tuscan "Appennino". This area is the mountainous area of Tuscany and approx 1 hour drive to Florence. There is a big kitchen with a fireplace, a bath-room, a dining-room and a study. On the first floor, there are 3 double bedrooms and 2 bathrooms. The farmhouse is surrounded by big beautiful garden where there is also a fountain under the Loggia, large pool and a traditional BBQ heated by wood to make your own fantastic Pizza. There are fifteen historical towns and villages situated around upper Mugello and Valdisieve such as a small historical village like San Godenzo whose foundation goes back to 1028 and its ancient Benedictine abbey is one of the most conspicuous examples of Roman architecture in Tuscany. ***Prices for 6 Pax include only the villa and not the dependence.
